Description how to reach the location and hotel recommendations by Tomas Vyhldal

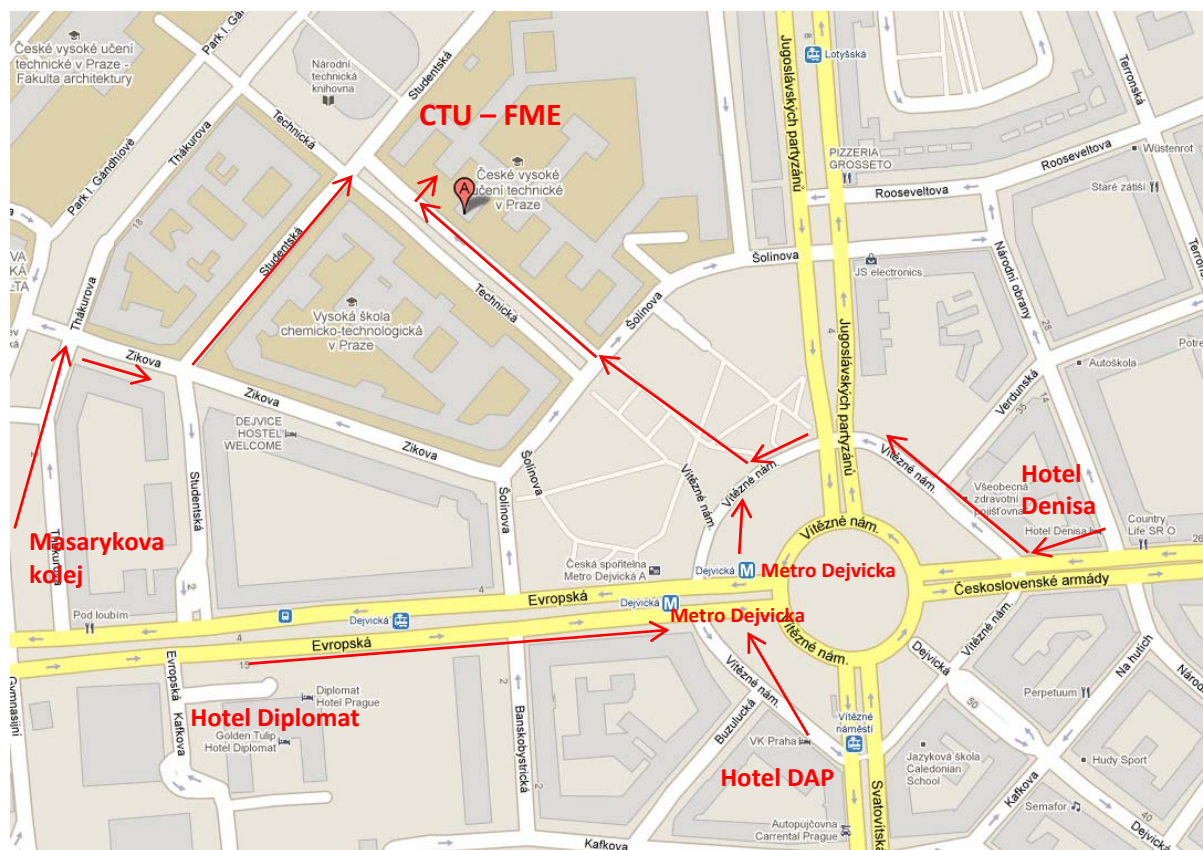
The meeting will be held in the rooms No. 17, and 18, by the dean's office of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering (Fakulta strojni), CTU in Prague (Ceske vysoke uceni technicke v Praze), Technicka 4 (ground-floor – you pass the reception, go straight and turn left).

If you stay in one of the hotels nearby the CTU campus, you may see the map below for the route to the venue CTU-FME. If you come directly from the airport, take bus 119 and go the end station Dejvicka. The stop is just by the Metro (underground) station Dejvicka. Then follow the map below as well. If you stay downtown, take Metro and go to the end-station of line A Dejvicka. Most of the CfC partners stay at DAP hotel (1. Hotel DAP <http://www.daphotel.cz/> - recently renovated army hotel)
